

## Draft Regulations for the North Queensland Khanacross Championship 2013

1. To enable any club to participate a minimum of 3 competitors must enter from that club. Any competitor from any club may enter regardless of the participation of that club.
2. The Series will consist of three rounds hosted by FNQMSC, WSCC and TCAC.
3. All events shall be run in accordance with CAMS Khanacross Regulations unless otherwise stated.
4. The Series shall be divided into 2wd and 4wd categories of equal standing. 2wd shall be separated into the following Classes;
  - <1600
  - 1600-2L
  - >2L
  - Ladies
  - Juniors (under 18 y.o.)
5. Any water trucks will be used in the fairest and most equitable manner possible.
6. Any night course will not count towards the result of a Series event.(lights are not required).
7. All driving tests shall be designed to be a test of driving skill and not course familiarity or memory.
8. Trophies to be awarded 1<sup>st</sup>, 2nd and 3rd in each Class, Juniors, Ladies, and Outright.
9. Points to be awarded in each Series event as follows. Class, Juniors, Ladies, and Outright.
  - 1<sup>st</sup> 10 points
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> 9 points
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> 8 points
  - 4<sup>th</sup> 7 points
  - 5<sup>th</sup> 6 points
  - 6<sup>th</sup> 5 points
  - 7<sup>th</sup> 4 points
  - 8<sup>th</sup> 3 points
  - 9<sup>th</sup> 2 points
  - 10<sup>th</sup> 1 points being the minimum score for a starter.
10. In case of breakdown or serious damage to a competitors vehicle a change of vehicle will be permitted at the discretion of the Series Director. Points will be awarded in the Class in which the majority of runs were completed.
11. Entry fee for the North Queensland Khanacross Championship 2013 will be \$100.
12. Entries close 15<sup>th</sup> April, 2013.
